

CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP
SPECIAL MEETING
May 6, 1998

The special meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Castle Rock Township was convened at the township hall at 7:00 p.m. Present were Alyn Angus, Norbert Kuhn, Jr. and Gordon Wichterman, Supervisors; and Michelle Nicoali, Clerk. Also present were , Richard Hocking, Carol Markuson, Jim Markuson, Buford Faust, Hugh Fischer, Maralee Rother, Wm. Neil., Jim Ozmun, Bill Fistch, Commissioner.

The meeting was called to order by Alyn Angus, Supervisor. The purpose of this meeting, which started immediately following a special hearing for a conditional use permit, is for Viking Auto Salvage, Buford Faust, to submit building plans adding more space to his existing building, and to aquire a building permit.

Norbert inquired how high the fence would be depending on the lay of the land, 10' to 12'. Trees were also planted around all 35 acres. They were only requested to put up 400' to 600' of fence at Markusons request and would like it noted that they did much more than required.

The purpose of the added space is for dismantling. At present they dismantle 6 to 8 cars a day and the added space will reduce the noise by 3 shifts a day.

The Markuson's would like the property expansion to the southern portion of the land. Concerns if they don't start moving that direction now they never will.

Dick Dubbels and Markuson's lawyer suggested that an EAW test be done.

A motion was made by Gordon Wichterman, seconded by Norbert Kuhn, to approve building permit, they must comply with MSI laws. Motion carried.
