

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
OCTOBER 26, 1999**

The regular BI-monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Castle Rock Township was convened at the town hall at 7:00 p.m. Present were Norbert Kuhn Jr., Vice-Chair, Jim Ozmun, Bill Neil and Ken Betzold, Supervisors, and Michelle Nicolai, Clerk. Also present were Shirley Dubbels, Gerry Drewry and Dan Nicolai Jr., Darrel Gilmer and Jim Switzer..

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Norbert Kuhn Jr. Vice-Chairman, the pledge of allegiance was recited.

MEETING MINUTES

October 12, 1999. A motion was made by Bill Neil, seconded by Ken Betzold to approve minutes. Motion carried. 4 Ayes.

Building Permit

Tom Kosier 22110 Beaumont Way applied for a building permit to put up a 40' x 60' storage shed. 12' sides. Steel siding. On a 2 1/2 acre lot. Bill Neil made a motion, with the stipulation that he has it approved by the Architectural Committee, in writing, before the permit is issued, seconded by Jim Ozmun to approve. Motion carried. 4 Ayes.

Joint Powers Agreement

The board will review the Cannon River Joint Powers Agreement and discussed the next meeting.

The board A motion was made by Ken Betzold, seconded by Bill Neil to approve the Joint Powers agreement and sign for the Vermillion River Watershed.

The board will review the Rural Solid Waste Joint Powers Agreement for the next meeting.

Certification of Mileage for Township Road

Building Permit Switzers Nursery

Northern Cannon River Watershed

The concern of ground waters and the aquifers. Building Code

Inspector Murphy gave us a copy of expiration dates for permits and they must have it started within 180 days, and we have them started within 60 days. The board decided we would stay with 60 days.

Bill Peters old place is beginning to get a pile of cars behind the pine trees. We put a letter about unlicensed cars in our last newsletter..

Permit Fees with a \$50 minimum

A motion was made by Jim Ozmun, seconded by Ken Betzold to approve to send a letter to the Johnson's about their permit fee.

Roads

The North Ditch on 270th West of Biscayne needs to be cleaned. Cost will be \$500 to \$600 to clean the ditch. Supervisor Neil will contact Ferd Volkert and have him sign an agreement to clean the ditch and spread on his field. A motion was made by Jim Ozmun, seconded by Ken Betzold to approve \$500 on 270th and postpone 230th until spring.

Motion carried. 4 Ayes. Stop sign on 225th and Biscayne is bent and needs to be straightened.

A motion was made by Bill Neil, seconded by Ken Betzold to approve to adjourn.
