

**CASTLE ROCK PLANNING COMMISSION
SPECIAL HEARING
February 26, 2001**

The Planning Commission of Castle Rock Township held a special hearing on February 26, 2001 at 6:30 P.M. to review and consider an application for a condition use permit to allow Warren Johnson, 22140 Beaumont Way, Farmington, MN 55024 to relocate and fully restore a 30' x 32' pole building within the same property lines at the above address. Present were Bob Dubbels, Jim Heiman, Bill Fitch and Maralee Rother, commissioners. Also present were Mary Jo Fischer, Gerald Mangelson, Randy and Cindy Becker, Ken Betzold and Jim Ozmun.

Chairman Jim Heiman called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.
