## CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION SPECIAL HEARING DECEMBER 30, 2002 7:20 P.M.

The Planning Commission of Castle Rock Township held a special hearing on December 30<sup>th</sup> 2002, at the Castle Rock Town Hall. Present were Bob Dubbels, Arlyn Lamb, Maralee Rother, Fern and Ed Peterson, Sharon Noah, Brendan and Rick King, Dick Ozment, and Mark Wagenknecht.

Because there was not a quorum at 7:20 p.m., Bob Dubbels called the meeting to order at 7:25 p.m.

The purpose of this hearing is to consider and review the application of Ed and Fern Peterson, 1608 230<sup>th</sup> Street, Farmington MN 55024, for a conditional use permit to move in a mobile home to be attached to an existing mobile home on a site at 23134 Audrey Avenue, Farmington MN 55024.

The Planning Commission has copies of application, and a letter and stop work order dated November 25<sup>th</sup> from Ron Wasmund, Castle Rock Building Official, and two letters, dated December 10 2002 and December 12 2002, from Tom Berry, Shoreland Zoning Administrator, discussing the situation of construction activity and other problems at the site on 23134 Audrey Avenue.
