

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
REGULAR MEETING  
APRIL 9 2002**

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Castle Rock Township was convened at the Town Hall on April 9, 2002 at 7:00 p.m. Present were Ken Betzold Chair, Jim Ozmun Vice Chair, Bill Neil, Randy Becker and Doug Wiedder Supervisors, Maralee Rother Clerk and Roger Randall Treasurer. Also present were Shirley Dubbels, Robert Cox, Darryld and Janet Oistad, Jeff Laschinger, Millie Berg, Kathryn Jamison, Sgt. Jerry Cotton, Steve Mittelstaedt and Colin Garvey.

Chair Ken Betzold called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**APPROVE REORGANIZATION MEETING**

**Jim Ozmun made a motion and Randy Becker seconded to approve the minutes of the reorganization meeting of March 20, 2002 as written. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

**APPROVE REGULAR MEETING**

**Bill Neil made a motion and Jim Ozmun seconded that the minutes of the Board of Supervisors regular meeting of March 20, 2002 be approved and accepted with the following additions or corrections: the meeting started at 7:40 p.m. immediately following the reorganization meeting and the address on sign permit change. Motion carried. 5 ayes.**

**SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT**

Sgt. Jerry Cotton from the Sheriff's department was present. The nuisance problem at the Town Hall was discussed. It was also noted that Randy Becker had discussed the Landfill Recovery issue with Dave Bellows at the Township Officers meeting in March.

**BOB COX – CASTLE ROCK VILLAGE**

Bob Cox, 4370 278<sup>th</sup> Street Castle Rock had some questions about frontage for new house in a re-platted area. **Jim Ozmun made a motion and Randy Becker seconded that the Township will check with the County for platting area and consulting with the Township's lawyer for building requirements. Motion carried 5 ayes.** In regard to the well on the property with Auge, Bob Cox contact Ron Wasmund and have the well situation checked.

**INQUIRY ABOUT DECK**

Jeff Laschinger 23193 Chippendale Avenue Farmington inquired about the procedure to get a deck built on his property. The Clerk took his plans and will give them to Ron Wasmund to review and approve.

### **BUILDING PERMITS**

**Jim Ozmun made a motion and Randy Becker seconded that the Board approve a building permit for Mark Wagenknecht 1097 245<sup>th</sup> street east Farmington for a single-family dwelling with the stipulation of a letter of credit or performance bond to remove the old house six months after receiving the certificate of occupancy. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

**Randy Becker made a motion and Bill Neil seconded that the Board approve a building permit for Larry Garner 24483 Chippendale Avenue Farmington for a garage pole barn for storage for horse trailers, snowmobiles etc. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

**Bill Neil made a motion and Doug Wiedder seconded that the Board approve a building permit for Dakota Village at the Dakota County Fairgrounds to install a bathroom in Dakota Village and all fees were waived as a donation from the Township and Ron Wasmund the Building Official. Motion carried.**

### **MOWING PARKS**

**Jim Ozmun made a motion and Bill Neil seconded that the Township hire Wide Open Spaces 6140 280<sup>th</sup> Street East Elko MN 55020 for the 2002 mowing season for \$3195.00 for the same areas as 2001. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

### **ROAD COMMITTEE**

Road committee members Mark Henry, Ken Betzold and Paul Irrthum met with Norm Torbenson in regard to work on 275<sup>th</sup> street.

### **FARMINGTON FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Jim Ozmun talked with Robin Roland of the Farmington Fire Department in regard to the incorrect billing and \$1276.00 was refunded to the Township.

### **CEEF**

CEEF is an organization of communities working together (Castle Rock, Empire, Eureka and Farmington). CEEF sponsored the Easter Egg Hunt and Halloween Walk. CEEF co-sponsors the Community Expo with District #192 Community Education. **Bill Neil made a motion and Randy Becker seconded that the Township donate \$500.00 to CEEF. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

### **LIQUOR LICENSES**

**Jim Ozmun made a motion and Bill Neil seconded to approve the liquor license for the Dakota County Fairgrounds P.O. Box 73 Farmington MN for a temporary on sale license August 5 – 11 2002. Motion carried 5 ayes**

**Jim Ozmun made a motion and Bill Neil seconded to approve the liquor license for Fountain Valley Golf Club 2830 220<sup>th</sup> Street West Farmington MN for on and off sale license for 2002. Motion carried 5 ayes**

### **TRAILER SALES**

Colin Garvey 22098 Canton Court Farmington Truck Center requested a license for selling new trailers at the above address. A conditional use permit is required for retail sales in the commercial area so he will meet with the Planning Commission.

### **RESOLUTION FOR PRECINCT**

**Jim Ozmun made a motion and Bill Neil seconded to adopt the resolution for reestablishing unchanged precincts and polling places. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

### **ROAD RESTRICTION VARIANCES**

Roger Randall requested a road restriction variance for 240<sup>th</sup> street but doesn't need one because road restrictions would be off by the time he needed one.

Don Graber 3148 263<sup>rd</sup> Street, Rocky Hills addition does need one because 263<sup>rd</sup> street is a 4-ton road. **Jim Ozmun made a motion and Randy Becker seconded that the Township approve a road restriction variance for Don Graber 3148 263<sup>rd</sup> Street, not to exceed seven tons and he will be responsible for repairs of all damages to the road if any, after April 20, 2002 thru May 20, 2002. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

### **RESIDENCE SIGNS**

The Township received a letter in regard to residence address signs and the Clerk will send in the list now requesting signs and will put a notice in the Castle Rock Chronicle regarding the necessity of having the signs.

*Bill Neil left his chair.*

### **BURNING PERMIT**

Bill Neil discussed the need of permission from the Township to burn the road right-of-way on 270<sup>th</sup> Street and Akron Avenue. **Randy Becker made a motion and Jim Ozmun seconded that the Township give Bill Neil permission to burn the right-of-way on 270<sup>th</sup> Street and Akron Avenue. Motion carried 4 ayes.**

*Bill Neil returned to his chair.*

### **ROAD REPORT - - - -GRAVEL AND LIME ROCK**

**Jim Ozmun made a motion and Doug Wiedder seconded to approve the specs for the gravel and lime rock. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

### **ROAD INSPECTION**

The annual road inspection will be held on April 30, 2002 at 6:00 p.m. The road committee and Board of Supervisors will meet at the Town Hall.

### **SPRAYING DITCHES**

There was discussion of spraying ditches and if the ditches can't be sprayed by July 15, they should be mowed.

*Doug Wiedder left the meeting at 9:15 p.m.*

**DUST CONTROL**

Material to be used this year for dust control will be magnesium chloride. **Jim Ozmun made a motion and Bill Neil seconded to go through the Dakota County program for dust control material. Motion carried 4 ayes. Jim Ozmun made a motion and Randy Becker seconded to operate on the same basis as last year with the rate of \$35.00 for each additional 100-foot increment and the 300 feet footage will be given to Township residents, living on Township roads only and living within 250 feet of the road. Motion carried 4 ayes.**

**275<sup>th</sup> STREET**

In regard to the work on 275<sup>th</sup> Street, Engineer Grant Jacobsen has the plans in order. There will be a need for a permit for a borrow pit.

**ROAD REGISTRATION**

In regard to the status of Alamo, the Township will check with the County.

**ROAD MAINTENANCE REPORT**

Roger Randall gave a road maintenance report.

**TREASURER'S REPORT**

**Randy Becker made a motion and Bill Neil seconded to approve the treasurer's report. Motion carried 4 ayes.**

**CLAIMS**

**Randy Becker made a motion and Bill Neil seconded to approve the claims report with the addition of CEEF and Henry Excavating claims. Motion carried 4 ayes.**

**ADJOURN**

**Bill Neil made a motion and Jim Ozmun seconded to adjourn. Motion carried 4 ayes.**
