

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP
PLANNING COMMISSION SPECIAL HEARING
MARCH 10, 2004**

The Planning Commission of Castle Rock Township held a special meeting March 10, 2004 at the Town Hall. Present were Jim Heiman Chair, David Nicolai Vice Chair, and Maralee Rother Secretary. Also present were Bill Neil, Randy Becker, Jim Ozmun, Arlyn Lamb, Jon Juenke, and Todd Brennan.

The purpose of this special hearing was to review the request of Friedges Excavating, 21980 Kenrick Avenue, Lakeville, MN 55044 for a mineral extraction permit for the reconstruction of County Road 79 from Highway 50 to County Road 80.

Chair Jim Heiman called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The Planning Commission reviewed a memo received from SEH regarding items numbered within the memo of February 16, 2004. Number 9, regarding three soil boring logs have been submitted. In numbers ten and fourteen, Brian Watson of the Dakota County Soil and Water Conservation District will be involved, regarding the irrigation pivot protection and erosion control during the project. In numbers sixteen and seventeen, Dakota County will coordinate the project and will survey and give the Township an as-built and verify the elevation will be above 874 feet. Number twenty – the insurance meets the Townships requirement. In number twenty-one, the conditions have been satisfied and resolved.

Dave Nicolai made a motion and Maralee Rother seconded that the Planning Commission recommend approval of a conditional use permit for Friedges Excavating for a seasonal mineral extraction permit. Motion carried 3 ayes.

Maralee Rother made a motion and David Nicolai seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3 ayes.
