## CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION SPECIAL HEARING JULY 26, 2004

The Planning Commission of Castle Rock Township held a special meeting July 26, 2004 at 7:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. The purpose of this special hearing was to review the request of David Sender, 24900 Akron Avenue, Farmington, MN 55024, for a conditional use permit to operate a home occupation business of a dog daycare/boarding facility at the above address.

Dave Nicolai made a motion and Dave Kammueller seconded to recommend that the Board of Supervisors approve the request for a conditional use permit for a dog daycare/boarding facility with the following stipulations:

- 1. Maximum dogs in the facility will be twelve dogs. Motion carried 5 ayes.
- 2. Dogs will be caged inside and allowed outside in fenced area four times a day with supervision.
- 3. The kennels will be cleaned every day disposal of animal waste will be weekly with no stockpiling.
- 4. Noise level and nuisance laws will be governed if the Township is made aware of any problems.
- 5. The traffic will only be increased possibly on the weekend.
- 6. The owners have liability insurance and are bonded.
- 7. All dogs must be vaccinated and must have all their shots to be accepted into the facility.
- 8. There will be no gun training.

Motion carried 5 ayes.

Maralee Rother made a motion and Bob Dubbels seconded to adjourn. Motion carried 5 ayes.
