

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SPECIAL HEARING  
AUGUST 10, 2004**

A special hearing of the Board of Supervisors of Castle Rock Township was convened at the Town Hall on Tuesday, August 10, 2004. Present were Randy Becker Chair, Arlyn Lamb Vice Chair, Jim Ozmun, Russ Zellmer, and Paul Irrthum Supervisors, and Maralee Rother Clerk. Also present were Pete Schaffer, Jean Mulvihill, and Patrick Tinsley.

Chair Randy Becker called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The purpose of this hearing was to review and consider the request of Jean Mulvihill, 4925 250<sup>th</sup> Street East, Hampton, MN 55031, for a variance to build an accessory storage building at 27xxx 232<sup>nd</sup> Street East, Hampton, MN, 80 feet from the center of the road on 232<sup>nd</sup> Street, to keep building away from creek.

Discussion was held regarding the variance of 80 feet on 4925 232<sup>nd</sup> Street and the question was asked what the elevation was at the site of proposed building site. An elevation boundary survey showing elevations was not presented. A letter from Allen Matejka, 3135 232<sup>nd</sup> Street, Hampton, was presented, objecting to the storage building being built at this site, and stating it should be built at 4925 250<sup>th</sup> Street, Hampton.

**Arlyn Lamb made a motion and Paul Irrthum seconded to deny the request for a variance because of the lack of information showing elevation of the building site, and the presentation of a letter of objection from Allen Matejka, 3135 232<sup>nd</sup> Street, Hampton. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

**Jim Ozmun made a motion and Russ Zellmer seconded to adjourn. Motion carried 5 ayes.**
