

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP  
PLANNING COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING  
JANUARY 31, 2005

The Planning Commission of Castle Rock Township held a public hearing on January 31, 2005 at 7:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. Present were Jim Heiman Chair, Dave Kammueler and Bob Dubbels Planning Commission members, and Maralee Rother Secretary. Also present were Paul Irrthum, Dale Gehring, Arlyn Lamb, and Gert Sieg.

Chair Jim Heiman called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Comments from the public included the "hardship" provision, a second residence on a 40 acre parcel with a second driveway, and why would a mobile home be allowed.
