

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP
PLANNING COMMISSION SPECIAL HEARING
November 7, 2005

The Planning Commission of Castle Rock Township held a special hearing on Monday November 8, 2005 at the Castle Rock Town Hall. Those present were Jim Heiman Chair, Dave Kammueler Commissioner, and Maralee Rother Secretary. Also present was Pearl Shirley.
