

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULAR MEETING RECONVENED  
October 25, 2005**

The purpose of this meeting was to reconvene the October 11, 2005 regular meeting to discuss the 225<sup>th</sup> Street being built regarding Garvey's development. Present were Mike Rademacher, Russell Zellmer, Randy Becker, Arlyn Lamb, Paul Irrthum, and Maralee Rother. Also present were Jodie Ludden, Colin Garvey, Mark Henry, and Ken Betzold.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m., and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Discussion was held as to who owns the right-of-way on 225<sup>th</sup> Street.

Discussion was held regarding road usage.

Discussion was held regarding blading of the road while constructing roads in the development.

The Township needs a maintenance agreement with the City.

The Township would like to have Garvey rebuild 225<sup>th</sup> Street one-half mile east of Highway 3 to the end of Garvey property abutting the golf course.

**Arlyn Lamb made a motion and seconded by Russell Zellmer to allow Garvey to continue maintaining the road (225<sup>th</sup> Street) as long as there are trucks hauling and no complaints. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

**Paul Irrthum made a motion and seconded by Mike Rademacher to request Garvey have 'trucks hauling' signs on the road while trucks are traveling back and forth. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

**Arlyn Lamb made a motion and was seconded by Mike Rademacher to have two representatives from the Township meet with the City of Farmington representatives and get a maintenance agreement for 225<sup>th</sup> Street. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

Options discussed were:

Option I: Township maintains the road and City of Farmington pays the bill.

Option II: Keep maintenance of road and have city pay percentage of road usage.

Representatives are Board members Russell Zellmer, Paul Irrthum, and Mark Henry, road maintenance.

**Paul Irrthum made a motion and Russell Zellmer seconded that the Township postpone the decision until the regular meeting in November. Motion carried 5 ayes.**

**Arlyn Lamb made a motion and Mike Rademacher seconded to adjourn. Motion carried 5 ayes. Meeting adjourned at 8:35 p.m.**
