

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SPECIAL HEARING
April 12, 2005**

The Board of Supervisors of Castle Rock Township held a special hearing on Tuesday April 12, 2005, at the Town Hall. Present were Randy Becker Chair, Arlyn Lamb Vice Chair, Mike Rademacher, Russ Zellmer, and Paul Irrthum Supervisors, and Maralee Rother Clerk. Also present were Bill and Anita May, Joe May and Mark Wagenknecht.

Chair Randy Becker called the hearing to order at 6:30 p.m., and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The purpose of this hearing was to review the request of Adam Kraft 2240 138th Street East, Rosemount MN 55068 for a variance to be able to build farm buildings closer than 300 feet to the owner's residence at 25035 Blaine Avenue, Farmington MN.

The Board reviewed a memo received from Dean Johnson of Resource Strategies regarding a variance to residential building setback requirements.

Paul Irrthum made a motion and Arlyn Lamb seconded to deny the variance because there is no hardship. Motion carried 5 ayes.

Paul Irrthum made a motion and Arlyn Lamb seconded to instruct the Planning Commission to hold a public hearing on May 2, 2005 to amend Section 6.04 by eliminating B. 8. e. Motion carried 5 ayes.

Arlyn Lamb made a motion and Paul Irrthum seconded to adjourn the meeting at 6:55 p.m. Motioned carried 5 ayes.
