Natalyia stated that they will be looking for customers and none will come to them. The waste will be kept in a dumpster. No chemicals will be used and there will be no outside storage. The water jet cutter requires 3 phase electrical and they have discussed this with the electric company.

Dave Nicolai made a motion and Dave Kammueller seconded to recommend approval of the conditional use permit for a home occupation of ornament making with no outside storage with a three-year review. Motion carried 5 ayes.
