

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP  
PLANNING COMMISSION  
PUBLIC HEARING  
September 25, 2006**

The Planning Commission of Castle Rock Township held a public hearing on Monday, September 25, 2006 at 7:30 p.m. at the Castle Rock Town Hall, 2537 240th Street West (corner of 240th Street and Biscayne Avenue). Present were Bob Dubbels Chair, Dave Nicolai Vice Chair, and Maralee Rother Secretary. Also present were Jen Venz, Michael Monroe Kiefer, Cliff Salmon, Janet Zimmer, Russell Zellmer, Bernie May, Ron May, and Erv Zimmer.

Chair Bob Dubbels called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The purpose of the public hearing is to review a request for a conditional use permit for Jen Venz, 22340 Albatross Circle, Farmington, MN 55024 to operate a daycare in her home.

Jen Venz is going to class to get a state license for a daycare of 10 or less children. The state license allows up to 10 children. Hours will be 6:45 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and there will be no employees.

Michael Monroe Kiefer commented that this facility will have traffic impact on Albatross Circle.

**Dave Nicolai made a motion and Maralee Rother seconded to recommend approval of a state licensed daycare facility of ten or less children for Jen Venz at the above address. Time of operation will be 6:45 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with no weekends or holiday care. There will be no signs and no employees. Motion carried 3 ayes.**

**Dave Nicolai made a motion and Maralee Rother seconded to adjourn meeting. Motion carried 3 ayes.**
