

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SPECIAL MEETING  
March 27, 2007 – 7:00 p.m.**

Russell Zellmer Chair called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The purpose of the informal discussion is concerning issues related to the MinnCan Pipeline project.

Borings will be under the road in the right-of-way. There will be 4 ½ to 5 miles of pipeline from west to east, taking four to six weeks, starting in September 2007.

Access roads are not known yet; the road maintenance man will watch the road conditions. Machines will remain on easement property.

Jim Lentsch property-the pipeline will be bored in front of their house in the right of way. There will be 4 to 6 weeks construction with documents, permits and public utilities.

Brian Watson – they will be 6 feet deep into wetlands, soil and water conservation.

Discussion was held regarding condition exemption results – approval – escrow system

CRP ground – replant exact seed as what there before work

Contract – up to five years

Road crossings and haul routes need large escrows

The pipe weighs 80# per foot

Discussion of roads before and after project work.

Engineer will help township with discussion regarding:

\$100,000.00 Bond

5-6 miles of township roads

Cash escrow \$25,000 per mile

Engineer \$500.00 per day

Mike Foertsch will get more numbers before MinnCann pipe work starts.
