A special meeting of the Planning Commission of Castle Rock Township was held on Tuesday, June 22nd, 2010 at 6:30 P.M. Present were Sandy Weber Chair, Mark Wagenknecht, Arlyn Lamb and Lori Abeln, member and Secretary. Monique Berg was not in attendance. Also present were Jon Juenke, Dick Ozment and Drea Doffing.

CALL TO ORDER

Chair Sandy Weber called the meeting to order at 6:40 P.M. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The reason for the need of the special meeting was read.

Notice is hereby given that the Planning Commission of Castle Rock Township will hold a special meeting on Tuesday June 22, 2110 at 6:30 at the Castle Rock Town Hall, 2537 240th Street West (corner of 240th Street and Biscayne Avenue), to review a variance for Jon Juenke, 21701 Blaine Avenue, Farmington, MN 55025 for a setback of less than 130' feet from the center of the road to build a grain holding bin on the existing pad.

- **MOTION: Arlyn Lamb made a motion and Mark Wagenknecht seconded it to recommend to the Board of Supervisors that this variance is not necessary due to the fact that the capacity of the bin is not changing. Arlyn Lamb also requested that the fees only include the permit fee and the fine for not securing the initial permit.**
- **Findings of fact: Mark Wagenknecht said that the capacity of the bin is not changing, and should be grandfathered in. Does there need to be clarification from the lawyer on whether capacity is not changing if that is not a modification of the bin.**
- **MOTION: Mark Wagenknecht made a motion and Arlyn Lamb seconded it to adjourn. Motion carries 4 ayes.**
