

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-A

**CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP
DAKOTA COUNTY, MINNESOTA**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CASTLE ROCK TOWNSHIP
ZONING ORDINANCE TO OPT OUT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF
MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593**

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn. Stat. § 462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, section 462.3593, subdivision 9 allows towns to “opt out” of those regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that it is in the best interests of the Town to opt out of the new regulations and if the Town Board elects to address the issue of temporary family health care dwellings to do so directly as part of its zoning ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Castle Rock ordains:

SECTION I. Opt Out. Section V of the Castle Rock Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by adding a new 5.07 as follows:

5.07 Opt Out of Minnesota Statutes, section 462.3593


Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the Town of Castle Rock opts out of the requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings as defined therein.


SECTION II. Incorporation of Amendments. The Town’s staff is hereby authorized and directed to incorporate the amendments made by this Ordinance into the Castle Rock Township Zoning Ordinance and such updated version shall constitute the official Castle Rock Township Zoning Ordinance.

SECTION III. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and first day of publication.
