In response to the Executive Order of the Governor and guidance from the MN Department of Health and Centers of Disease Control for COVID-19, I am encouraging residents to conduct any business you may have with the township through phone calls or emails when at all possible. Our staff will continue to work the posted hours of 9am to 12pm on March 19th and March 23rd until the Board of Supervisors can meet to make an official determination on a public closure of the town hall to the public at a special meeting at 6:30pm on Monday, March 23rd. Until that time, I ask that you voluntarily limit your in-person contact for township business for those items that cannot be delayed or done via phone or email.

I understand that for 80% of our population these precautions may seem extreme, but the concerns of COVID-19 and its extreme threat to our most vulnerable citizens is not unfounded. It is my hope that our community is untouched by this pandemic and that by taking practical steps to protect those around us all of these actions will just be precautions.
