

Dakota County Rural Planning Comprehensive Plan Public Open House

Castle Rock Township is hosting a public open house on Monday, November 20, 2017, at 7:00 PM at the Castle Rock Town Hall, 2537 240th Street West, to provide background information and obtain public input on the new Dakota County Rural Collaborative Comprehensive Plan.

State law requires all cities, townships, and counties in the seven-county metropolitan area to update their comprehensive plans at least every 10 years. Castle Rock Township is part of a collaborative consisting of 11 townships and 5 cities in southern Dakota County to prepare a Comprehensive Plan for the area to meet this requirement. The new plan, which will be submitted by Dec. 31, 2018, will review existing conditions and address and project land use, housing, roads, transit, airports, wastewater services, parks, and open space for the next 10 years.
